




Do you think as a Beauty, Spa or Wellness provider, its your duty to educate and inform your clients on the dangers of the COVID-19 virus?





- More focus on Wellness , less on Spa
- Am sure some senses will no longer be the same eg: sense of touch some treatments will have to be done with the therapist wearing gloves and to some extent smell if we have to put on masks
- Once the danger of infection is over clients will return to their usual spa treatments. We will keep extra precautions in place for the forseeable future
- Cleanliness and hygiene standards will be critical, cleints will expect to see 'hygiene' mission statements in all facilities and protocols may even be something displayed in public areas. Hygiene in communal and thermal areas will be hypercritical as features like locker rooms, saunas and steam rooms are all DIY areas, where standards must be very high in future
